Lunken Cadet Squadron Emblem

Adopted and Approved 6 MARCH 2023

The Lunken Cadet Squadron Emblem is of the disc and scroll design. The disc is Azure (blue) with a gules (red) bend bordered in Argent (white). Upon the field are four argent (white) mullets: Chief, Sinister, Base and Dexter. At dexter is a historic Civil Air Patrol logo charged as an argent (white) equilateral triangle with a Gules (red) three bladed propeller. At sinister is an argent (silver) stylized aircraft.

A runway is represented by a broad red bar with white border running from top left to bottom right of the disc. This bar represents the Lunken Airport runway which pays tribute to the Lunken Cadet Squadrons original location at the historic Lunken Tower in Cincinnati Ohio. The four white stars located at the top, bottom, left and right of the disc represent the Civil Air Patrols four core values of Integrity, Excellence, Volunteer Service and Respect. Like the stars, the core values surround all aspects of the Lunken Cadet Squadron. The former Civil Air Patrol Logo: The disc contains the former Civil Air Patrol logo of a white equilateral triangle and a three-bladed propeller in red to service as a historical tie to Civil Air Patrol's past as well as Civil Air Patrols three primary missions of Aerospace Education, Emergency Services and Cadet Programs. The stylized aircraft silhouette represents both the love of aviation and serves as a reminder to always look out for your wingman.

The colors also have significance. The disc is composed of five colors. The red, white and blue- represent patriotism and support of the United States and the state of Ohio; as well as reflecting the colors of both of their flags. The gray represents the challenges of leadership as leaders are often called upon to use their discretion and make challenging decisions using the core values as a guide. The black represents the strength of the team, and how it holds all aspects of the squadron together in the pursuit of the Civil Air Patrol missions.
