

## 177th MANSFIELD SQUADRON, GLR-OH-177



**Description:** ???

**Significance:** Based on the Ohio Burgee, the official flag of the state designed in 1901 by John Eisenmann and adopted the following year, the design incorporates two Civil Air Patrol elements. In the lower field, the silhouette of a Cessna 172 represents the squadron's aircraft for both search and rescue operations and for cadet orientation flights. In the upper field, the Civil Air Patrol corporate logo is seen, its three sides symbolic of the three primary missions: cadet programs, aerospace education, and emergency services.
