



1. Yellow and black background is for the Cincinnati Miss P51 yellow and black checkerboard. This is an airplane that is located in the Cincinnati Warbird Museum at the Clermont County Airport. Our squadron meets at the Clermont County Airport.
2. The horse is a reference to the Mustangs. Our squadron nickname is the "flying Mustangs"
3. The 5 stars incorporated into the horse has the CAP connection of: Leadership, Character Development, Aerospace, Physical Training, and Emergency Services
4. The lone red star is symbolic of the greater Cincinnati area. (That's about where Cincy would be on a map of Ohio if it filled the whole circle).
